• Übung 1:

1. If the sun shines (shine), we will go (go) for a walk.
2. If you wait (wait) a minute, I will ask (ask) my dad.
3. If my boyfriend doesn't phone (not / phone) today, I will leave (leave) him.
4. If you don't study (not / study) hard, you won't pass (not / pass) the exam.
5. My mum will be (be) angry with me, if I don't send (not / send) her a picture postcard.
6. If I find (find) my swimsuit, we can have (can have) a swim in the lake.
7. If you want (want) us to stay friends, don't do (not / do) that again!
8. If the weather is (be) right, we can give (can give) it a go.

• Übung 2:

1. If you told (tell) your mum, she would be (be) very angry.
2. If I had (have) more time, I would learn (learn) Salsa.
3. If it wasn't (not / be) that cold, I would take (take) the dog for a walk.
4. If little Tim got (get) more pocket money, he would spend (spend) it on sweets.
5. Would you still love (you / still love) me if you won (win) the lottery? – Yes, of course. Well, I would miss (miss) you, but I would still (still love) you.
6. If I didn't feel (not / feel) so tired, I would go (go) to the cinema with you.
7. She wouldn't phone (not / phone) you all the time if she wasn't (not / be) interested in you.

8. I would help (help) you if I knew (know) how.

1. If I had been (be) at the airport in time, I wouldn't have missed (not / miss) the plane.

2. If our team (train) had trained harder, we would have won (win) the competition.

3. If we had gone (go) to a better restaurant, we would have had (have) a decent dinner.

4. Would you have believe (you / believe) him if you hadn't known (not / know) him?

5. I could have rung (can ring) him if I had known (know) his phone number.

6. I wouldn't have said (not / say) that if I hadn't been (not / be) absolutely sure.

7. If we had had (have) more time, we could have visited (can visit) more sights.

2. If they had had (have) time, they would have come to see us.

3. They wouldn't have stolen (not / steal) his money if he hadn't kept it in such an obvious place.

4. She would go (go) out with you if only you were brave enough to ask her.

5. If you change (change) your mind, please let me know.

6. If my dad doesn't (not / pick) me up, I will take the bus home.

7. If you didn't do (not do) it, nobody would do it.

8. My girlfriend will meet (meet) me at the office if she gets the afternoon off.

If you hadn't spent all your money, you could have bought a new bicycle.

6. Wenn seine Eltern nicht so viele Probleme hätten, wären sie glücklicher.
